## Section 4. Structure of the GEOC and Subcommittees (approved 4/26/22) MEMBERSHIP<sup>5</sup>

The purposes of the commit ee shall be to:

- Create, regularly review, and update guidelines and processes to be used for approving General Education courses;
- Approve the alignment of undergraduate courses with specific General Education requirements;
- Coordinate with all academic units to ensure appropriate distribut on and of erings of General Educat on courses;
- Evaluate, in coordinat on with the University Academic Assessment Commit ee, the General Educat on program's ef ect veness. Results shall be reported to the Senate annually;
- Recommend modif cat ons to the General Educat on program and its Student Learning
  Outcomes to the Senate. Recommendat ons must consider input from Faculty and the
  Of ce of Academic Af airs, and report on impact studies; and
- Recommend modif cat ons to its own Advisory Subcommit ees to the Senate. Solicit reviewers
  from among the Faculty for General Educat on courses and assign courses to them for review.
  The review process is

- —Human Expression, Humanity in Context, and Communicating Through Writing
- -Hands-on Science, Solut ons Through Science, and Quant tat ve Analysis
- —Social Configurations and Social Issues
- —First Year Seminar and Experient al Learning
- —Personal Wellness

The membership of these advisory subcommit ees shall be as follows:

Subcommit ees will consist of five Faculty members, all elected at large by the Faculty. No more than three members may be from the same Unit. Subcommit ees may request that the GEOC modify their membership to a number between three and seven; the GEOC will approve this request if it considers the subcommit ee's workload warrants this change.
